The Registered Nurses Professional Development Centre is pleased to offer the following course from our RN Bridging/Re-entry Program for Internationally Educated Nurses.

Professional Nursing in Canada

This online plus classroom course is designed to familiarize Internationally Educated Nurses (IENs) with professional concepts, issues, and professional practices for registered nurses in Canada. The course focuses on the development of critical thinking, evidence-based practice, effective communication skills, an introduction to legal and ethical frameworks, and the Canadian health care system. Concepts related to health promotion, family nursing, cultural sensitivity, and nursing research are also explored. Self-directed study using computer based lessons and face-to-face classroom sessions facilitate learning.
